Ordinance No. 103.

A Bill for an Ordinance making a special assessment of special taxes on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the streets oiled in Oiling District No. 3. and levying said special tax against the property liable therefor.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins, as follows:-

Section 1. Whereas by ordinance of the City of Hopkins No. 99 Oiling District No. 3. was formed, and whereas by resolution of the City of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of said city and Approved by the mayor of said city, No.6. and whereas in pursuance of said ordinance and resolution the said Board of Aldermen caused certain streets in said Oiling District to be oiled, and whereas the said Board of Aldermen by its ordinance No. 100 has approved the oiling of such streets and the costs thereof, That the following named streets in said district No. 3. were so oiled and the costs thereof approved, to wit,
Barnard Street from Fourth Street to Eight Street, and

Fourth Street from Roseberry street to Warren Street.

The total number of lineal feet of said streets so oiled is One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty Eight feet, and the total cost of oiling said streets was Four Hundred Forty Three and 20/100 Dollars, and the number of lineal feet on the two sides of said streets so oiled is Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy feet exclusive of the crossings of such streets, or intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleys, and the cost per lineal foot on each side of such streets would be Sixteen Cents.

Section Two. Thereis, therefore, hereby levied a special tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, which tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed five cents per linear foot per month on the property abbuting on said streets so oiled, and tax bills shall be issued according to law and the ordinances of said city against all the lots or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, in amounts and described as follows;
