Pursuant To adjournment of last meeting for the purpose of passing an Ordinance, approving the Oiling of Streets in Districts No, - One, Two, -Three, and Four, in the City of Hopkins, Missouri. There was presented an ordinance, and placed upon its first reading and read as follows, - ----- ORDINANCE NO, 110. -----

A Bill for an Ordinance approving the Oiling of certain Streets in Districts Nos, One, -Two, -Three, and Four, in the City of Hopkins Mo.

Be it ordained by the Board of Alderman of the City of Hopkins, as follows;

Section-1. Whereas, by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, No.(99) the City of Hopkins was divided into Four convenient Oiling Districts and whereas by resolution of the City of Hopkins, ~~### ad##### #y ### #####~~ Nos, -(9) and passed by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins, and approved by the Mayor, of said City, and whereas, in pursunance of said Ordinance and resolution, the said Board of Aldermen has caused the following, streets in said City to be Oiled in said districts, as follows;

In Oiling District, No.-1. Roseberry Street from the East side 4th, Street to Railroad Street; Third Street, from Barnard Street, to One-Hundred an Twenty feet South of Roseberry Street; Barnard Street from ~~###~~ West side of Fourth Street to East side of Seconed street; Railroad Street from Roseberry Street, to Warren Street.

In Oiling District, No, - 2. Third Street from One Hundred and twenty feet south of Roseberry stree, to Caroline Street; Fourth Street from Roseberry Street, to Mc Pherson Street; Seconed Street, from Morehouse Street to Caroline Street; First Street from Morehouse Street to Caroline Street. Morehouse Street from First Street to Sixth Street, Sixth Street from North side of Morehouse Street to Mc Pherson Street. Roseberry Street from Fourth Street to Tenth Street.

In Oiling District, No, - 3. Barnard Street from Fourth Street to Eight Street, and Fourth Street from Roseberry Street to Warren Street.

In Oiling District, No, - 4. Barnard Street from East side of Seconed Street, to West side of Third Street.

On Motion Made, and Seconed, That this Ordinance be read a seconed time, This motion prevailed and it was read a seconed time,

On motion Made and Seconed, That this Ordinance be read a third time and put upon its final passage, This motion prevailed, and it was read a third time, Mayor then Put the Question, Shall this Ordinance be passed and the names of each of the Aldermen was called as follows; E. A. Miller.-Yea.-E. B. Brown, -Yea, - Fred. Gray, -Yea, -P. W. Shafer, -Yea.

Mayor Mutti, Then declared the Ordinance passed, and fourthwith returned it with his approveal endorced thereon and the same attested by the City Clerk and the Seal of said City affixed thereto, Dated this the 10th day of July, 1922. and instructed the City Clerk, to place a true Copy of said Ordinance upon the City Records, and it shall be known as Ordinance No, (110)

There was presented an Ordinance makeing a special assessment of Special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the Streets oiled in Oiling District, No. 1. and levying said special tax against the property liable therefor.

On motion it was ordered placed upon it First readin and was read as follows.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins, as follows.

Section.- I. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins-No(99) Oiling District, No. 1. was formed and Whereas, By Resolution, of the City of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of Said City and approved by the Mayor of said City, No,8. and whereas in pursuance of said Ordinance and resolution ,the said Board of Alderman caused certain streets in said o#### Oiling Districts to be oiled and whereas the said Board of Aldermen by its Ordinance No.(110) has approved the oiling of such streets and the costs thereof; that the followin named streets in said District. No. 1 were o#### so oiled and the costs thereof approved, to-wit.

Roseberry street from East side of Fourth Street to Third Street; Third Street from Barnard Street to One Hundred and Twenty feet South of Roseberry Street; Barnard Street from West side of Fourth Street to East side of Seconed Street.

The Total number of Lineal feet of said streets as Oiled is Eighteen Hundre And Seventy Two feet, and the total costs of Oiling said Streets, was Six Hundred and Thirty Five and 10/100 Dollars and the number of lineal feet on the two sides of said streets so oiled is 2117 feet exclusive of the crossings of such streets or #### intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleys and the cost per lineal feet on each of such streets, would be Thirty Cents.

Section , - 2.- There is therefore. hereby levied a special tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, which tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed fice cents per lieneal foot per month on the property abutting on said streets so #### a oiled, and tax bills shall be issued according to law and the Ordinances of said City against all the Lots or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, in amounts as described as follows;

Be it ordained by the board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as follows.

Section, -1. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, Nos- (99) Oiling District, No- 2. was formed, and Whereas by Resolution of the City of Hopkins passed by the Board of Aldermen of said city and approved by the Mayor of said City, No- 8- and whereas in pursuance of said Ordinance and resolution the said Board of Aldermen caused certained streets in said oiling Districts, to be oiled and whereas the said Board of Alderman by its Ordinance No-#110 . has approved the oiling of such Streets in said District No- 2. were oiled and the costs thereof approved. -to-wit.

Roseberry Street from East side of Fourth Street, to Third Street; Third Street from Barnard Street, To One Hundred and Twenty feet South Of Roseberry Street, Barnard Street from West side of Fourth Street, to the East side of Seconed Street,

The total number of lineal feet of said Streets so oiled is Seven-Thousand Three Hundred and Thirtee, feet, and the total cost of oiling said Streets was Nine Hyndred Ten, and 53/100 Dollars, (\$ 910.53) and the Number of lineal feet on the Two sides of said Streets so oiled is, 10117 exclusive of the crossings of such streets or ##### intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleys, and the cost per lineal feet on each side of such streets would be NINE CENTS.

Section, - 2. There is Therefore hereby levied a Special Tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled which Tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed five cents per per lineal foot per month on the propertyabutting on said strees so oiled
