Mayor Mutti, then Put the Question, Shall this Ordinance be Passed. and the names of each Aldermen was called, and answered as follows;

Mayor Mutti, Then declared the Ordinance passed, and forthwith returned it with his approveal endored thereon, and the same attested by the City Clerk, and the Seal of said City Affix thereto, Dated this the 10th day of July 1922. and instructed the City Clerk to place a true copy of said Ordinance upon the City Records, and it shall be known as Ordinance, No. 111, Passed and Approved, June, 10th, 1922.

There was submitted a bill for an Ordinance making a special assess ment, of special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or border ing on the streets oiled in Oiling District, No, 2. and levying said special tax against the property liable therefor.;

Motio made and Seconed that it be put on its first reading, this motion prevailed, and it was read as follows;

Be it ordained by the board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as follows.

Section, -1. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, Nos- (99) Oiling District, No- 2. was formed, and Whereas by Resolution of the City of Hopkins passed by the Board of Aldermen of said city and approved by the Mayor of said City, No- 8- and whereas in pursuance of said Ord inance and resolution the said Board of Aldermen caused certain streets in said oiling Districts, to be oiled and whereas the said Board of Alder man by its Ordinance No-#110 . has approved the oiling of such Streets in said District No- 2. were oiled and the costs thereof approved. -to-wit.

Roseberry Street from East side of Fourth Street, to Third Street; Third Street from Barnard Street, To One Hundred and Twenty feet South Of Roseberry Street, Barnard Street from West side of Fourth Street, to the East side of Seconed Street,

The total number of lineal feet of said Streets so oiled is Seven- Thousand Three Hundred and Thirteen, feet, and the total cost of oiling said Streets was Nine Hyndred Ten, and 53/100 Dollars, (\$ 910.53) and the Number of lineal feet on the Two sides of said Streets so oiled is, 10117 exclusive of the crossings of such streets or ##### intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleys, and the cost per lineal feet on each side of such streets would be NINE CENTS.

Section, - 2. There is Therefore hereby levied a Special Tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled which Tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed five cents per per lineal foot per month on the property abutting on said strees so oiled

and Tax Bills shall be issued according to law and the Ordinances of said City against all the lots or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said Streets so ciled, in amounts and described as follows;

Ther Was submitted a Bill for an Ordinance making a special assess-ment of Special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the streets oiled in oiling District NO- 3.- and leveying said special tax against the property liable therefore;

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as follows;

Section,-1. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins No,-(99) Oiling District, No,- 3 was formed, and Wereas, by resolution of the City of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of said City and approved by by the Mayor of said City,-No,-8 and whereas in pursurant of said Ordinance and resolution the said Board of Aldermen caused certain Streets in said Oiling District to be oiled, and whereasthe said Board of Aldermen by its Ordinance NO, 110. has approved the oiling of such streets and the cost thereof; that the named streets in said District NO- 3. were so oiled and the costs thereof approved, to-wit;

Roseberry Street from East sid of Fourth Street to Third Street; Third Street from Barnard Street to One Hundred and Twenty feet South of Roseberry Street; Barnard Street from west side of Fourth Street to East Side of Seconed Street;

The total Number of lineal feet of said Streets so oiled is 1732ft and the total cost of oiling #said Streets was TWO HUNDRED FORTY ONE, and 20/100 (241.20) DOLARS, and the number of lineal feet on the Two sides of said Street so Oiled is 2680ft, exclusive of the crossings of such treets or intersections formed by the crossings of such street or alleys, and the cost per lineal foot on each side of such streets would be- Nine-Cents.
