

There was submitted a bill for an Ordinance making a Special assessment of Special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the Streets Oiled in Oiling District, - No 4.- and levying said Special tax against the property liable therefor-;

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as follows-;

Section-1. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, NO (99) Oiling District NO-4.- was formed, and whereas, by resolution of the City Of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of said City and approved by the Mayor of said City, NO- 8. And Whereas in pursuance of said Ordinance and resolution the said Board of Aldermen, caused certain Street in said Oiling District to be oiled, and whereas the said Board by its Ordinance NO,- 110. has approved the oiling of such streets and the costs thereof; that the following named streets in said District, NO,- 4. were so oiled and the costs thereof approved, to-wit.

Roseberry Street from East Side of Fourth Street to Third Street; Third Street From Barnard Street To One Hundred and Twenty feet South of Roseberry Street ; Barnard Street from West side of Fourth Street to East side of Second Street;

The total number of lineal feet of said streets so oiled is FOUR HUNDRED AND SIXTEEN feet, and the total cost of oiling said streets Was FORTY ONE, and 04/100 Dollars, (41.04) and the number of lineal feet on the Two sides of said streets so oiled is- 456ft, exclusive of the crossings, of such streets, or intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleys and the cost per lineal foot on each side of such streets would be- Nine Cents.

Section.- TWO. THERE is therefore hereby levied a special tax on all the property fronting or bordering on (said Streets so oiled, which tax shall be a ^(which) ~~leen~~ on said property, and does not exceed five cents per lineal foot per month on the property abutting on said streets so oiled, and tax bills shall be issued according to law and the Ordinances of said City against all the lots, or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said Streets so oiled, in amounts, and described as follows;
