BOARD OF ALDERMEN, Met at the Clerks Office in Adjourned session July 20th 1923, for the perpose of considering the passing of Ordinances refering to a Special tax levey on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordring on the Streets resently oiled in the oiling districts Nos-One-Two, -Three, -and Four, and such other business that shall come before it.

There was presented ~~and~~ by the City Attny, - A BILL-for an Ordinance makeing a special assessment of Special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the Streets oiled in Oiling District No-ONE- and leveying said Special tax against the property liable therefor, -

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins Mo. as follows;-

Section, -1. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, No-99 Oiling District No-One. Was formed and Whereas, by Resolution of the City of Hopkins Passed by the board of Aldermen of said city, and approved by the Mayor of said city, No-10, and whereas in pursurance of said ordi- and Resolution the said Board of Aldermen, caused certain streets in said Oiling Districts to be oiled, and whereas the said Board of Aldermen by its Ordinance, No- 118. has approved the oiling of said streets and the costs thereof; that the following named streets in said District No, -One. were oiled and the oiling and thereof approved, - to-wit^z

Roseberry Street from East side of Fourth Street to Railroad Street. Third Street From Barnard Street to One hundred and Twenty feet South of Roseberry Street, Barnard Street from West sid of Fourth Street to the East side of Seconed street, Railroad Street from Roseberry Street to Warren Street.

The total number of lineal feet of said streets so oiled is TWENTY-THREE HUNDRED-feet (2300) and the Total costs of oiling said streets was FIVE^zHUNDRED TWENTY^zNINE and 26/100 Dollars, and the number of lineal feet on the two sides of said Streets so oiled is 21.170 exclusive of the crossings of such streets, or intersections formed by the crossings of # such streets or alleys, and the costs per lineal feet, on each side of such streets would be -Twenty-Five Cents.

Section- 2. There is therefore, hereby Levied a Special Tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, which tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed five-cents per leneal foot per month on the property abutting on said street so oiled, and Tax-bills shall be issued according to law, and the Ordinances of said City against all the lot#s or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, in amounts and described as follows, -;
