## ORDINANCE, NO. - 120. ----

A Bill for an Ordinance making a special assessment of Special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the streets oile ed, in Oiling District, -No-TWO. and leveying said Special tax against the property liable therefor:

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins As follows,;

Section, -1. Whereas by ordinance of the City of Hopkins, NO, - 99. Oiling District No- TWO- was formed, and whereas, by resolution of the City of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of said City, and approved by the Mayor of said City, No-10 and whereas in pursuranceof said ordinanc and resolution the Said Board of Aldermen, caused certain streets in said oiling District, to be oiled, and whereas, the said Board of Aldermen by its Ordinance No-118. approved the oiling of said streets and the Cost s thereof, that the following named streets in said District, No- TWO-were oiled and the oiling and costs thereof approved, to-wit.

Third Street from One-Hundred and Twenty feet South of Roseberry Street, to Careoline Street, Fourth Street from Roseberry Street to Mc, Pherson Street, Seconed Street, from Morehouse Street, to Careoline Street, First Street from Morehouse Street to Careoline Street, Morehouse Street from First Street, to Sixth Street, Sixth Street from North-Side of Morehouse Street to Mc, Pherson Street, Roseberry Street from Fourth Street To Tenth Street, Seconed Street, From Morehouse Street to Roseberry Street.

The Total number of lienal ## feet of said Streets is-SEVEN THOUS AND EIGHT-HUNDRED and EIGHTY-THREE -feet, and the Cost of oiling said streets was SEVEN-HUNDRED-THIRTY-EIGHT and 91/100 DOLLARS. and the number of lineal feet on the two sides of said Streets so oiled is 10553 feet exclusive of the crossings of such streets, or intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleyes, and the Cost per lineal foot on each side of such streets would be -SEVEN-CENTS.

Section-2. There is therefore, hereby levied a Special tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said Streets so miled, which tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed five cents per lineal foot per month on the property abbutting on said streets so oiled, and tax-bills shall be issued according to law, and the ordinancees of said City against allthe lots or pracels of ground fronting or bordering on said street so oiled, in amounts and described as follows,;
