

-----ORDINANCE, NO- 121.-----

A Bill for an ordinance making a special assessment of Special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the Streets Oiled in oiling District No.-THREE.-and levying said Special tax against the property liable therefor,-

Be it ordained by the Board of Alderman of the City of Hopkins Mo as follows,;

Section 1. Whereas by ordinance of the City of Hopkins, - 99 Oiling District No-THREE, was formed and Whereas, by resolution of the City of Hopkins, passed by the board of Aldermen of said City and Approved by the Mayor of said city, No- 10, and whereas in pursuance of said ordinance and resolution the said board of aldermen caused certain streets in said oiling district to be oiled and whereas the said board of aldermen by its Ordinance No- 118. has approved the oiling of said streets, and the costs thereof; that th following named streets in said District -THREE,- were oiled and the oiling and costs thereof approved,-to-wit;

Barnard Street from Fourth Street-to Eight-Street, Fourth Street from Roseberry Street to Warren Street Fith Street from Barnard Street To Craig Street Craig Street from Fifth Street to Eight Street Eight Street from Craig Street to Mc Farland Street, Mc Farland Street from Eiths Stre et, to the Center of Section One (1)

The total number of lineal feet of said Streets so oiled is FOUR-THOUSAND FIVE Hundred and EIGHT,- feet and the Total costs of oiling said Streets was FIVE HUNDRED EIGHT³/₄NINE and 40/100 DOLLARS, and the number of lineal feet on the two- sides of said Streets so oiled is-8420. feet exclusive of the crossings of such street, or intersections formed by the crossings of such streets or alleys, and the cost per lieal foot on each side of such streets would be-Seven-Cents.

Section-.2 There is ~~there~~, levied a Special tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, which tax shall be a lien on said property and which does not exceed five cents per lineal foot per month on the property abutting on said street so oiled and tax bills shall be issued according to law and this ordinances of said city against all the lots or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, in amounts, and described as follows.;
