-:-ORDINANCE, NO. (59)

A Bill for an Ordinance levying the Poll Tax in the City of Hopkins, for the year 1914.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins, as followes.

All male persons between the ages of Twenty One, and Fifty Years, who have resided within the corporate limits of the City of Hopkins for thirty days prior to the passage of this act, are hereby required to work on the Streets and alleys of said City two days for the yeat 1914 or in lieu thereof to pay to the street commissioner, the sum of Two, (2).

Dollars, and if said work is not done at the time and place at and for which notice is given by the street commissioner, said Two Dollars shall immediately become due and payable, and suit shall be brought for the collection thereof according to law, and the City attorney shall be allowed a fee of Five, (5) Dollars for bringing such suit, which fee shall be taxed as costs against the defendent in such suit against whom judgment is rendered.

This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Passed and approved this the 5th, day of May, 1914.
