-:-:-:-: BY AND BETWEEN, CITY OF HOPKINS AND E.M.WILHOIT, OIL CO. -:-:-:-:-

-:-:-: THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 12th day of Nov, 1914.
by and between the City of Hopkins, Nodaway County Missouri, of the First
Part, and E.M.Wilhoit, of the second part, Witnesseth-;

That in consideration of the sum of Eighteen (18) Dollars per
annum payable in advance, the said First party gives and grants to said
second party the right and privilege of using the following real-estate,
"to-wit;

Begining at the Railroad right-of-way, directly West of the
North End of Block, Twelve, (12) in said City, Thence, East to the East
line of said Block Twelve, (12) in said City, Thence, North Thirty (30)
feet, Thence West to the Railroad right of-way, Thence in a South West-
erly direction along said Right-of-way to begining, for the purpose of
erecting thereon storage tanks for illuminating, oils, gasoline and
lubricating oils, and selling such oils and gasoline therefrom.

It is agreed that in case the street is opened up over said
property the said E. M. Wilhoit, will vacate said property with-in
Thirty, (30) days after receiving notice of the opening of said street,
and said notice may be served on any person in charge of said property,
and have the same effect as though served on second party.
