

ORDINANCE NO- (73)

A bill for an ordinance to issue Bonds, of the City of Hopkins, in accordance with Ordinance No-(72) of said City, as voted by the legal voters of said City of Hopkins, at the special election, held in pursuance, of said ordinance, on April, 3d, 1917.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as follows:

Sec.- 1. It is hereby declared that at the special election held in the City of Hopkins Missouri April, 3d, 1917 in accordance with ordinance, NO-(72) of the City of Hopkins, more than two thirds of the legal voters of said City voting at said election, voted in favor of the creation of a debt of One Thousand Dollars, by said City, and in favor of the levy of a Tax of 25 cents on the \$100.00 assessed valuation of the City of Hopkins.

Sec.- 2. It is hereby ordered that Ten Bonds, each for the sum of \$100.00 bearing date the 18. day of May, 1917, be issued; Five of said Bonds shall be payable One Year after date, and Five of said Bonds, shall be payable Two Years after date, said Bonds shall bear interest at the rate of Six per cent per annum, payable Semi-annually on the 18. day of November, and May, in each year; the principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at the Office of the City Treasurer, in the City of Hopkins Missouri, said bonds shall have interest coupons attached and said bonds shall be attested by the signatures of the Mayor and City clerk of said City of Hopkins and have affixed thereto the corporate seal of said City.

Sec.- 3. Said bonds shall be sold, and the proceeds used in accordance, with said Ordinance No-(72) of the City of Hopkins, passed and approved on the 12th day of March, 1917.

Sec.- 4. This Ordinance shall be in force and affect from and after its passage and approval.
