BOARD OF ALDERMEN Met pursuant to adjournment, at the Clerks office, Sept, 12th, 1919.

Board met for the purpose of passing Ordinances, referring to Oiling the Streets of the City of Hopkins, MO.

There was presented, by the City attourney, the following Ordinance. When on motion made, and Seconed, - That it be placed upon it first reading, this motion prevailed and it was read by Mr Brown as follows, -:

A bill for an ordinance approveing the oiling of Streets in Districts, - No's ONE, - TWO, - and THREE, - in the City of Hopkins, Missouri, -:

Be it ordained by the board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins Missouri as follows, -:

Section, -1. Whereas, by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, No, -81. the City of Hopkins, was devided into Three Conventent Oiling, ts Districts, and Whereas, by Resolution of the City of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of said City of Hopkins, - NO.-2. and Whereas in pursuance of said Ordinance and said Resolution, the said Board of Aldermen, has caused the following streets, in said City to be oiled in said Districts as follows, -

In oiling District, -No.1, Barnard Street from the West side of 2nd Street to the East side of 5th Street, :

Third Street from the South side of Morehouse Street, to Barnard Street Roseberry Street from 3, - Street, to 4th, Street, and Fourth Street from the South side of, Roseberry Street to the North side of Warren Street.

In oiling District No.2. Morehouse Street from West side of ,Third, Street to West side of Seconed Street, - Seconed Street from South side of Morehouse Street to South side of Careoline Street, - Careoline Street from west side of Seconed Street, to First, Street.

In oiling District No, -3. Barnard Street, from the East side of Fifth Street, to the East side of Eight, Street.

And the said Board of Aldermen having examined said Oiled Streets in said Oiling Districts, -No's- ONE, -TWO, and Three, - and the Cost thereof, the sa same is hereby approved.

Section, .2. - This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approveal.

Motion made and Seconed, that this ordinance be read a Seconed time, this motion prevailed, and it was read a seconed time.

Motion mader and Seconed that this ordinance, be read a third time, and put upon its final passage, this motion prevailed, and it was read a third time.

Mayor Donlin, Then put the question, : Shall this Ordinance be Passed and the Names of each Alderman was called as follows, -:

- E. A. Miller, -Yea, -E. E. Fike, -Yea, -P. W. Shafer, -Yea, -Oliver. Lewis, Yea.

Mayor Donlin then declared the Ordinance Passed, and forthwith returned it with his approveal, endorced thereon, and the same attested by the City Clerk, and the seal of said City thereto, dated this the 12th day of September, 1919. and instructed the Clerk, to place upon the City Records, a true Copy of said Ordinance, and it shall be known as ordinance NO.-83. and found recoerded, on page (124)
