A Bill for an Ordinance making a special assessment of Special Tax, on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the Streets Oiled in Oiling District NO.-ONE) and levying said special tax against the property liable therefor.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as

follows, -:

Section.1. Whereas by Ordinance of the City of Hopkins, -No, -(81) Oiling District, No-ONE- was formed and whereas by resolution of the City of Hopkins, passed by the Board of Aldermen of said City and Approved by the Mayor, of said City, -No-(4) and whereas in pursuance of said Ordinance and Resolution the said Board of Aldermen caused certain streets in said Oiling District to be oiled, and whereas the said Board of Aldermen by its Ordinance, -No, (83) has approved the oiling of such streets, and the costs Thereof, That the following named streets in said district No, - ONE_ were so Oiled and the costs thereof approved, - to-wit,

Barnard Street from the West side of 2nd Street to the East side of 5th, Street.
Third Street from the South side of Morehouse Street to Barnard

Street,
Roseberry Street from 3d, Street to 4th Street.

Fourth Street from the South side of Rosebery Street, to the North

side of Warren Street.

The Total number of lineal feet of said streets so Oiled is Three-Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty feet, and the Total costs of Oiling said Streets was Twelve Hundred Fifty Two and 16/100- Dollars and the number of lineal feet on the two sides of said Streets so Oiled is Three Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen feet, exclusive of the Crossings of such Streets or intersections formed by the crossings of said streets, and the cost per, linear foot on each side of such streets would be, THIRTY TWO CENTS.
