

-- Ordinance No. 93.--

A bill for an ordinance approving the oiling of certain streets in Dis. No. 1, 2, & 3, in the city of Hopkins, Mo.

Be it ordained by the board of aldermen of the city of Hopkins, as follows.

Section One.

Whereas by ordinance of the city of Hopkins, No. 81 the city of Hopkins was divided into three convenient oiling districts and whereas by resolution of the city of Hopkins, passed by the board of aldermen of said city and approved by the mayor of said city, No. 5 and whereas in pursuance of said ordinance and said resolution the said board of aldermen has caused the following streets in said city to be oiled in said districts as follows.

In oiling district No. 1, Fourth St. from the North side of Roseberry St. to the South side of Barnard St.
Third St. from the South side of Morehouse St. to the South side of Roseberry St.

In oiling district No. 2, Morehouse St. from west side of 3rd, St. to West side of 2nd, St., 2nd St. from South side of Morehouse St. to south side of Caroline St., Caroline St. from West side of 2nd St. to 1st, St.

In oiling district No. 3, Barnard St. from the East side of 5th St. to the East side of 8th St.

And the said Board having examined said oiled streets in said oiling Districts 1, 2, & 3., and the costs thereof, the same is hereby approved.

Section 2,

This Ordinance shall be in effect on and after it's passage and approval.
