

## Ordinance No. 94.

A bill for an ordinance making a special assessment of special tax on the property adjoining and fronting on or bordering on the streets oiled in oiling district No. 1. and levying said special tax against the property liable therefor.

Be it ordained by the board of aldermen of the city of Hopkins, as follows; -

Section 1, Whereas by ordinance of the city of Hopkins, No. 81. Oiling District No. 1, was formed, and whereas by resolution of the city of Hopkins, passed by the board of aldermen of said city, and approved by the mayor of said city, No. 5, and whereas in pursuance of said ordinance and resolution the said board of aldermen caused certain streets to be oiled, and whereas said board of aldermen by its ordinance No. 93. has approved the oiling of such streets and the costs thereof, that the following named streets in said district No. 1 were so oiled and the costs thereof approved, to wit, Fourth St. from the North side of Roseberry St. to South side of Barnard St. Third St. from the south side of Morehouse St. to the south side of Roseberry St.

The total number of lineal feet of said streets so oiled is 896ft. and the total costs of oiling said streets was \$460.80 and the No. of lineal feet on the two sides of said streets so oiled is 1440 ft. exclusive of the crossings of said streets, or intersections formed by the crossings of said streets, and the cost per lineal foot on each side of such streets would be 32 cts.

Section 2, Therefore there is hereby levied a special tax on all the property fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, which tax shall be a lien on said property, and which does not exceed five cents per linear foot per month on the property abutting on said streets so oiled, and tax bills shall be issued according to law and the ordinances of said city against all lots or parcels of ground fronting or bordering on said streets so oiled, in amounts and described as follows to wit: -
