

---Ordinance, No. 97.---

A bill for an ordinance permitting the Hopkins Electric light and Power Co. to put a monthly surcharge of fifty cents on each electric light meter in the Co. plant and to ~~reduce~~ raise the rate of the city lights 50% per month each., and fixing the rate that may be chgd.

Be it ordained by the Board of Alderman of the city of Hopkins, as follows.-

Section 1.

Whereas it appearing to the said board of alderman that the Hopkins Electric Light and Power Co. is running at a loss, said Co. is hereby permitted to place a surcharge not exceeding 50 cts. per month on each meter furnished by said Co. to it's patrons, and is hereby permitted to raise the price of each street light furnished the city of Hopkins 50% per month.

Section 2.

The inhabitants of said city shall be furnished electricity for light and power purposes at a rate not exceeding the following,-

A minimum charge of one dollar and 50 cts. per month per meter.

25 cts	per	K.W.	for	the	first	6	K. W.	per	month.
20 "	"	"	"	"	"	next	10	K. W.	"
15 "	"	"	"	"	"	"	10	"	"
10 "	"	"	"	"	"	"	74	"	"

Section 3.

All sections of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance is hereby revoked, but nothing in this ordinance shall effect the contract of the city with said co except the change in the amount of payment herein mentioned, and said board reserves the right to repeal the ordinance and reduce the prices.

Section 4.

This ordinance shall be in affect on and after it's passage and approval.
